MINING AND QUARRYING - SAFER CONDITIONS FOR WORKERS, THANKS TO OIRA.

Mining and quarrying can be dangerous occupations. Hazards associated include operating high-risk, heavy machinery, loud noises, exposure to dust, explosions and fires. It is essential and legally required for employers in this sector (and in all others) to carry out regular risk assessments. Three Online interactive Risk Assessment (OIRA) tools developed by our Italian, Lithuanian and Portuguese partners for mines and quarries seek to make this task more accessible. DISCOVER THE NEW INDICATOR ON 'SERIOUS NON-FATAL ACCIDENTS' IN AN ENRICHED OSH BAROMETER TOOL

New indicators and functionalities have been added to the OSH Barometer data visualisation tool, providing valuable perspectives on occupational safety and health (OSH) in Europe. Among the new additions is the “Serious non-fatal accidents” indicator — based on Eurostat data — showing those accidents that cause more than 6 months of sick leave or permanent disability. DELIVERING A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE: AN IOSH REPORT

IOSH has launched a report to highlight how the OSH profession can support the delivery of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Launched on 25th September, Delivering a sustainable future, focuses on how IOSH believes good OSH management can contribute to 51 of the 169 targets that sit beneath the 17 SDGs. Of these 51, it can make a direct contribution to 31.

In the report, IOSH maps these targets to elements of good OSH management, which it hopes will support businesses in identifying how their activities can support the goals, through delivering good OSH, protecting workers and promoting health and wellbeing.

These elements are:

- Risk management
- OSH management systems
- Performance management and governance
- Welfare
- Occupational health
- Chemical hazards
- Vulnerable workers
- Ethical business practice
- OSH legislation
- Business continuity



This report follows on from the IOSH Catch the Wave campaign, launched in November 2021, which showcased how businesses which look after their people are much more sustainable. Take a look at the IOSH report Delivering a sustainable future.
