- Support cooperation, research, education and awareness activities

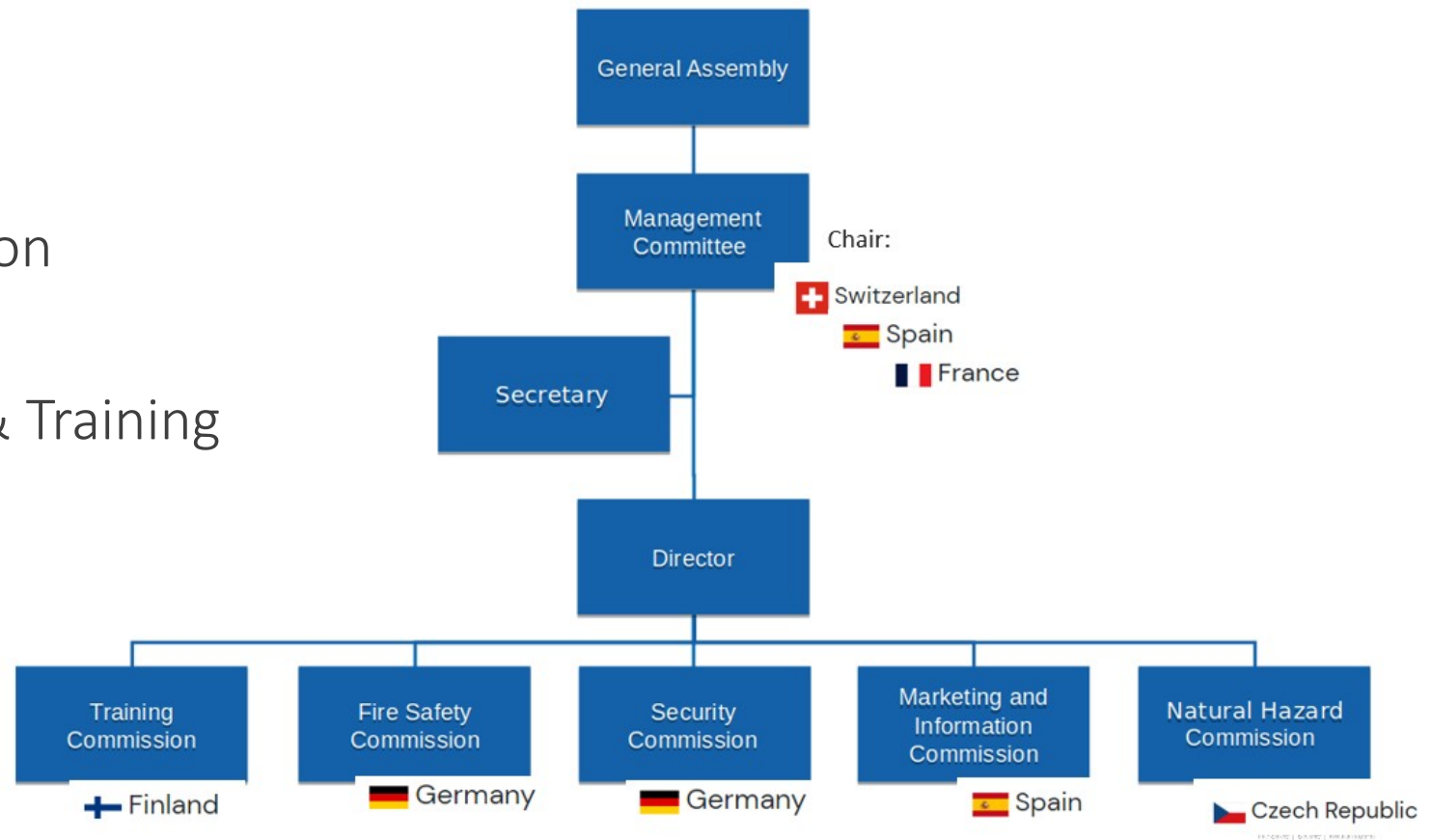
