Ukraine



- 86% of businesses stopped in February 2022, GDP fell by 29.1% (1/3) in 2022
- 9000 killed, 15117 injured civilians by May 2023
- 8,3 million refugees abroad, 8 million inside the country
- 11 million people (1/4 of the population) have fled their homes
- People at work are at risk of death
